Dr. D. K. Nauriyal, Professor of Economics in the Department of Humanities & Social Sciences, has been working at IIT Roorkee since 1985. He started his career as a lecturer in HNB Garhwal University, Srinagar and after sometime joined erstwhile University of Roorkee, now IIT Roorkee. He has published over 50 research papers in National and International journals and conferences and supervised eight Ph.D. works and currently supervising six Ph. D. scholars. He has organized 14 short term programmes, 11 Executive Development programmes and conducted 21 consultancy projects. He has delivered expert

lectures in different domains of Economics in the various universities and educational institutions across India.

Dr. Nauriyal has undertaken six major research projects awarded by The World Intellectual Property Ogranisation (Geneva), Ministry of Social Welfare (GOI), UGC, UNDP, and MORD (GOI).
