At the outset, the Director, Prof. S.C. Saxena introduced Shri Ashok Bhatnagar, to the members of the Board of Governors and welcomed him as the Chairman, Board of Governors of IIT Roorkee, on behalf of the Institute and on his own behalf. All the members joined the Director in welcoming Shri Ashok Bhatnagar. The Director also thanked Shri Jai Prakash Gaur, the outgoing Chairman and recorded the Institute's appreciation for his able



leadership and guidance, during his tenure as the Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Institute.

Before taking up the agenda, Shri Ashok Bhatnagar, the Chairman, Board of Governors, stated that it was an honour for him to be appointed the Chairman of the Board of Governors of his alma-mater, and expressed the desire that the IIT Roorkee continues to excel in all its endeavours in the future. Item No.25.2.1: To consider the revised cost of the Multistoried Boys Hostel being constructed by the CPWD.

The Finance Committee had considered the issue vide item No.21.3. The recommendations of the Finance Committee were placed before the Board of Governors. After discussion, the Board approved the recommendations of the Finance Committee.

RESOLUTION NO.BG/11/2009: RESOLVED THAT the revised estimate of Rs.30,10,96,633.00 based on the actual expenditure be approved as it was within the approved plinth area rate of the CPWD.

The Departmental Development Fund (DDF) be utilized for the following purposes:

- (1) Development of departmental infrastructure facilities for laboratories, class rooms and committee/ conference rooms.
- (2) Repair, maintenance and A.M.C. of equipment.
- (3) Seed money for holding conferences/ workshops and seminars etc.

The budget for utilization of the DDF for the above purposes may be recommended by the Professorial Committee of the Department and approved by the Dean, SRIC.

(ii) Transfer of Staff Costs out of Sponsored Research Project to Institute Fund:

In the Sponsored Project amount charges under the budget head of faculty time, staff costs and salary of the regular faculty will be transferred to the Institute receipts. Further, if any amount is provided by the sponsoring agency as honorarium to the investigators as one of the components in a Sponsored Research Project, the same may be distributed among them.

(iii) Payment of charges to travel agents for air ticket purchase assistance and visa assistance from projects/PDF:

A travel agent may be paid as under from the respective Consultancy Project/ Sponsored Research Project/PDF:

- (1) Visa service charges : upto Rs. 1000/-
- (2) Service charges for air-ticket purchase
 (i) upto Rs.300/- for domestic travel
 (ii) upto Rs.500/-for international travel

This will be effective from 1st July 2009.

- **Note-1** Request for permission to retain an Institute residence for the specific duration should be made to the Chairman, HAC on the prescribed Performa at least one month before due date of retirement/ due date of proceeding on leave or within 2 months of the death of the staff, in case of condition (f) request should be made within a week of the letter of dismissal or termination received by the concerned person.
- **Note-2** A residence retained under this clause must be vacated within the period as specified under Rule 8.1 or the date up to which permitted, whichever, is earlier. Permission to retain the house beyond the maximum period specified in Rule 8.1 will be at the enhanced license fee specified in Rule 9.1 and shall in no case exceed six months.
- **Note-3** In case of those staff who would be drawing pension from the Institute the license fee and other charges (Electricity/water) of the residence will be deducted from their pension every month. In other cases license fee must be paid in advance in quarterly installments. First installment should be deposited in the Institute within a week of grant of such permission. The permission, so granted shall terminate automatically, if the license fee for any quarter is not paid, as stipulated above and such occupation will amount to unauthorized occupation and action shall be taken as per Rule 12.
- **Note-4** In case of conditions (c) and (d) above, after six months, the allottee shall shift his/her belongings to a one-room accommodation elsewhere, at a monthly License Fee of Rs.200/-. If he/she wants to retain the residence after the six month period, the License fee would be Rs.5,000/- p.m. upto the next six months. Thereafter, he will have to vacate the residence. In case, the residence is not vacated after one year, enhanced license fee shall be charged as per Rule 9 of the House Allotment

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Rules. These license fees may be reviewed after three years.

Item No. 25.5.3: Developments for IIT Mandi (H.P.):

The Board of Governors noted that IIT Roorkee has been given the responsibility by the Government of India to mentor a new IIT at Mandi (Himachal Pradesh). For this purpose, building of old Central Library of IIT Roorkee has been earmarked and renovated to function as IIT Mandi Cell. In order to coordinate various activities related to IIT Mandi, a 5-member coordination committee has been constituted with Dr. S.P. Gupta, Professor of Electrical Engineering as Coordinator. IIT Mandi Cell is functioning similar to a Department.

Initially, the new institute will start with three B.Tech. Programmes in (i) Electrical, (ii) Mechanical and (iii) Computer Science & Engineering. The intake in each branch is 40. The counselling of prospective students has already been done during June 9-16, 2009. First batch of 120 students will join IIT Mandi on 22nd July 2009.

For the new students, teaching will be organized at IIT Roorkee campus in the first year. The lecture classes of the new students will be held in a 120 seats Lecture theatre at IIT Mandi Cell, which is also equipped with a state-of-art computer lab and a library, exclusively for IIT Mandi students. Tutorial and practical classes will be held in concerned departments. Curriculum, course structure, syllabus and Rules and Regulations for 2009-2010 academic year (1st year) are same as that of IIT Roorkee. The teaching of IIT Mandi students will be conducted by the regular faculty of IIT Roorkee. IIT Mandi students will have access to all facilities at par with students of IIT Roorkee. In summary, the new students shall be groomed with the state-of-art facilities of IIT Roorkee.

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IIT Mandi students will reside in the campus in an exclusive wing of Rajendra Bhawan (Boys Hostel) and Kasturba Bhawan (Girls Hostel). Boys will be accommodated in double seated rooms exactly similar to the rooms given to IIT Roorkee students and shall be under the care of a separate Residential Warden.

The development of IIT Mandi as a world class institution has also been initiated at Kamand, about 10 km from Mandi town at a picturesque site sprawling over 530 Acres of lush green pine trees with a 'Uhl' river flowing across them. The foundation stone was laid on Feb.24, 2009. In order to transfer the said land for IIT Mandi, following actions have been initiated:

- A Project Report has been prepared giving details of various *Khasra* numbers of land, courses to be taught at IIT Mandi in next 10 years, financial outlay for construction of various buildings etc.
- For transfer of forest land to IIT Mandi, services of a retired Chief Architect of HPSEB, who is based at Mandi and is a Senior Partner of an architectural consulting firm Design Solution Group, is being hired for developing the land use plans.
- An amount of Rs.41500.00 has been transferred to Principal, ITI Mandi as per the request of Joint Director, Technical Education (HP) for demarcating and counting of trees in the forest land to enable speedy completion of the land transfer process.
- Efforts were made to register IIT Mandi as a Society in Himachal Pradesh under Societies Act, which were not successful since the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has repealed the old Society Act. As per MHRD advice, attempt is now underway to register IIT Mandi as a Society in Uttarakhand.
- The post of Director for IIT Mandi has already been advertised on May 22, 2009. Now 30 posts for faculty and one post of Registrar are being advertised. The process of advertising non-teaching posts is also underway.



Item No.25.5.4: Progress made in the implementation of capacity expansion programme due to OBC reservation.

The Board noted that the Institute is implementing the enhancement in the student intake in all its courses by 54% over that of the sanctioned intake of the year 2006-07 in a phase manner, spread over a period of 3 years starting from the year 2008-09.

Therefore, in academic year 2008-09 18% enhancement in intake has been done. Accordingly, all facilities and infrastructure are being augmented.

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

A. RATES OF REMUNERATION / HONORARIUM AND NORMS FOR CONDUCTING SPONSORED / QIP COURSES :

Note :

- 1. The payment of honorarium and travel expenses to outside experts as well as retired faculty may be made in cash immediately after their last lecture. Advance for this purpose may be drawn in favour of the Course Coordinator / Faculty member on the recommendation of the Head, Continuing Education / Coordinator, Q.I.P.
- 2. It would be mandatory that lecture notes be given by the experts invariably in all the courses, except in some courses where the Coordination Committee of the course decides not to give the lecture notes.
- 3. (a) The meeting / lecture rates will also be applicable to all other type of meetings / lectures related to the QIP Centre.
 - (b) The meeting and lecture rates may be adopted for activities in Centre of Continuing Education for the courses / workshops etc. conducted in the Consultancy mode.

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- 4. Out side Experts may travel by taxi / own car irrespective of their entitlement, subject to the approval of the competent authority.
- 5. Outside Experts will also be entitled to claim their travel expenses on actual basis subject approval by the competent authority.
- 6. The travel of IITR faculty / staff will be governed as per the provisions of Institute TA / DA rules.
- 7. For courses outside Roorkee, the persons concerned will have to take leave of absence as applicable, including special casual leave / project leave.
- 8. Resource persons stationed at Roorkee will be treated at par with the staff of IIT Roorkee.
- 9. All the courses shall be run through the Centre of Continuing Education / QIP Centre.

B. ADVANCE PREPARATION OF COURSE MATERIAL :

- (i) The Head, Continuing Education Centre / Professor & Coordinator, QIP Centre may decide in advance for preparation of lecture notes and advise the course coordinator to draw time table for the course.
- (ii) According to this time table, teachers may be requested to give the write-ups of their lecturer notes at least a week before the start of the course.
- (iii) In case the course is not conducted due to any unforeseen reason, the following honorarium may be paid:
