The Chairman welcomed the members to the  $5^{th}$  meeting of the Building & Works Committee of the Institute. He expressed happiness that all the members were present.

#### **Deliberations:**

All the items on the Agenda were discussed, and the deliberations/recommendations are summarized as under:

## Item No. 1.0: Confirmation of the minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Building and Works Committee held on 21.02.2003.

Having received no comments on the minutes, the B&WC confirmed the minutes of the above meeting as recorded and circulated. Further, the Committee was of the view that last minutes of the meeting be annexed with the Agenda.

## Item No. 2.0: Actions Taken Report on the minutes of 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the B&WC held on 21.02.2003:

The B & W C noted the actions taken on the minutes of the above meeting, given on pages 2 and 3 of the agenda note with the following observations:

- Item No. 4.1 Changes, if any, in the drawing to incorporate the jobs of Air-cooling and Electrification of the Senate Hall, be accepted.
- Item No. 4.2 Interse priority between Azad, Rajendra & Cautley Bhawans be decided by DOSW, and construction scheduled accordingly.

### Item No. 3.0 ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:

# Item No.3.1 Considered the proposal for construction of 28 Nos. multistoried Faculty Residences and according Administrative Approval & Expenditure Sanction.

The Committee approved the Preliminary Estimates of Rs. 521.00 lacs as submitted by the C.P.W.D. for construction of another 28 Nos. multistoried Faculty Residences and recommended the same to the BOG for according administrative approval and expenditure sanction.

The Committee was also apprised by Er. S.P.Singh, that the actual cost was likely to be about 10% lower than the projected cost.

The details of the Preliminary Estimates are given at Appendix 'A'.

## Item No.3.2 Considered the proposal for widening and strengthening of Road from SDM Chowk to BEG&C Gate of HT Roorkee:

The Committee approved the Preliminary Estimates amounting to Rs. 14.00 lacs for widening and strengthening of Road from SDM Chowk to BEG&C Gate of IIT Roorkee with the following observations and

recommended the same to the BOG for according administrative approval and expenditure sanction.

- 1. The use of the land to be utilized for widening and strengthening the road will be transferred to IIT Roorkee, for this purpose.
- 2. The Nagar Palika will put up ornamental plantation on both the sides of the road, with adequate protective structures to prevent encroachment,
- 3. All temporary structures will be removed by the Nagar Palika.
- 4. Barriers would be provided and operated by BEG&C at appropriate places on the road.

The details of the Preliminary Estimates are given at **Appendix 'B'**.

## Item No. 3.3 Considered the proposal for Construction/ Raising of the existing Boundary Wall around the Institute Campus for Security purposes.

The Committee approved the Preliminary Estimates amounting to Rs. 61.00 lacs for new construction and raising the height of the existing Boundary Wall around the campus and recommended the same to the BOG for according administrative approval and expenditure sanction.

The details of the Preliminary Estimates are given at **Appendix 'C'**.

# Item No.3.4 Considered the proposal for providing a separate kitchen in the residences of block Nos. 147/172 to 147/208 of 'D' Group Colony in Vikas Nagar.

The Committee observed that an appropriate name be given to this colony, and approved the Preliminary Estimates amounting to Rs. 6.54 lacs for providing a separate kitchen in the residences of Block Nos. 147/172 to 147/208 of 'D' Group Colony in Vikas Nagar.

The details of the Preliminary Estimates are given at Appendix 'D'.

# Item No. 3.5 Considered the proposal for filling up three posts of J.E. Grade II (Civil) and one post of Technical Assistant (Sanitation) for the Construction Division, IIT Roorkee for Construction and Maintenance Works:

Er. Salek Chand, Institute Engineer briefed the Committee that due to paucity of supervisory staff, the Institute is facing a lot of problem for handling day to day sanitation and maintenance work of the entire campus. After deliberation, the Committee decided that three vacant posts of J.E. Grade-II (Civil) and one vacant post of Technical Assistant (Sanitation) for the Construction Division, IIT Roorkee for Construction and Maintenance Works be filled up subject to the ceiling laid down by Government of India i.e.1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the vacancies, subject to a maximum of 1% of the Cadre strength may be filled up. The correct position regarding vacancies be checked up and the matter placed before the, Finance Committee/Board of Governors for specific approval of filling of vacancies.

## Item No.3.6 Considered the proposal for constitution of a sub-committee to finalize the process and enlist a Panel of Architects for the Institute.

After deliberation, the Committee decided that the under mentioned Sub-committee be constituted to empanel 10 Architects for Works Planning, Architectural and Engineering Works of the Institute.

- 1. The Director briefed the Committee that there was a need for renovation/modernization of the Hangar of the Institute. The B&WC accepted the proposal in principle and decided that a detailed plan for renovation/modernization of the Hangar retaining its historic characters, be placed before the B&WC for approval.
- 2. The proposal for a new Gate opposite the newly constructed BEG&C gate was accepted in principle and it was decided that the detailed drawings, estimates and arboriculture plan be placed before the Director for specific approval.
