A detailed presentation on the four above mentioned proposals was made before the Building & Works Committee by the representatives of the Architects, M/S Venkataramanan Associates Ltd., Bangalore, who also answered the questions raised by the members on the floor. After discussion, the B&WC decided that the work of the four abovementioned proposals be assigned to the NBCC with the provision that the total cost including the Agency charges should not exceed Rs. 231.49 crores as approved earlier in the meetings of the Finance Committee & Board of Governors held on 5th March 2014.
