At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the members. He thanked and placed on record the valuable contributions of the outgoing B&WC member Prof. S.K. Ghosh, Department of Civil Engineering, in the meetings of the B&WC.



The Chairman also welcomed Prof. C.S.P. Ojha, Department of Civil Engineering, as a new member of the B&WC and wished for his active participation.

The agenda was then taken up.

Item No. 46.1: To consider the proposal for Renovation, Face-lifting & Facade Lighting of the James Thomason Building.

The B&WC discussed the proposal and recommended the same to the FC and BoG at a preliminary estimated cost of Rs. 20.24 crore.

Following suggestions were made by the committee for the effective implementation of the proposed renovation works:

- 1. The work should be executed in a phased manner. Efforts should be made to ensure minimal disturbance or disruption in the functioning of the sections/offices.
- 2. In order to ensure good quality of works, a team of domain experts, in addition to the Engineers and Architects should be constituted.
- 3. Since the James Thomason Building is a heritage structure, all the planned renovations and interventions should be carefully documented for the future.
- 4. The work shall be planned in such a way that the estimated budget spans two to three financial years, while the tender may be awarded in one go.

Item No. 46.2: To consider and approve the revised cost for the work of "Construction of New Block for Mathematics and Humanities & Social Sciences (HSS) departments at Vigyan Kunj."

Since the variation is less than 10% of the approved estimated budget for the project, the B&WC suggested that further action may be taken in accordance with the provisions in GFR 2017 and as per the practice being followed by CPWD in such cases.



Under any other item:

Item No.46.3 To consider the observation as brought to the notice of B&WC on the minutes of 45th meeting w.r.t. item no.45.7.

Dean Infrastructure and Institute Engineer, members of the B&WC brought to the notice of the Committee that in the 45th meeting while considering item 45.7 and recommending the demolition of nine existing old houses for the construction of Phase–III faculty residential accommodation in Vikas Nagar, a mention of demolition of four garages was missed. It was requested to include the same as the demolition of these old garages is also necessary for the execution of the project.

The B&WC deliberated and recommended the demolition of nine houses and four garages to FC and BoG. Details of the same are enclosed in (Appendix 'A').

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
