The agenda was then taken up.

Comments received from the Technical Section-1, Ministry of Education, Department of Higher Education, New Delhi vide letter F.No.7-8/2017 TS-I dated 21.11.2022 were considered during the deliberations.

Item No. 51.1: To confirm the minutes of the 50th meeting of the Finance Committee held on 08.03.2022.

Since no comments were received, the circulated minutes of the 50th meeting of the Finance Committee were confirmed.

Item No. 51.2: Actions taken report on the Minutes of the 50th Meeting of the Finance Committee held on 08.03.2022.

The Finance Committee noted the actions taken on the minutes of the 50^{th} meeting of the Finance Committee.

Item No.51.3: To consider the Budget proposal of the Institute for the Financial Year 2023-24.

The Finance Committee considered the Budget Estimates of the Institute for the Financial Year 2023-24 as given in **Appendix-A** and recommended the same to the Board for approval.

Item No 51.4: To consider the "Upgradation of Hostel Network" at IIT Roorkee.

The Finance Committee considered and recommended the proposal to the Board for estimated project budget of 68 crore.

Further, the FC advised that standard procedure on financial approval be followed before release of the tender.

Item No. 51.5: To consider the recommendations of Institute Technical Committee to write off the 04 major unserviceable items of Electrical Engg. Department under Normal Wear & Tear.

The Finance Committee considered the proposal and recommended the same to the Board for approval.



Item No. 51.6: To consider the proposals as recommended by the B&WC in the meeting held on 11.11.2022

The Finance Committee considered the recommendations of the B&WC, taken in the $47^{\rm th}$ meeting held on 11.11.2022 and recommended to the Board as follows:

S1. No.	Item	Recommendations
1.	To consider the revised cost of construction for a new Building for Mehta Family School of Data Science and Artificial Intelligence at IIT Roorkee.	Recommended the revised cost of Rs.34.5 crore on account of increase in the built up area and composite design structure', provided it falls in the scope of the tender which is already floated. Further, the FC advised that standard procedure on financial approval be followed in all cases.
2.	To consider the cost escalation for construction of Multi-Storey Apartments for Faculty and Group-'A' Officers at Vikas Nagar.	Recommended the escalated cost of Rs.33.98 crore to the Board for the ministry's approval to apply for additional HEFA funding.
3.	To consider escalation in the cost of construction of Students' Hostel of 800 capacity at Vigyan Kunj.	Recommended the escalated cost of Rs. 30 crore to the Board for the ministry's approval to apply for additional HEFA funding
4.	To consider the revised cost for the construction additional floors over the B-Block of Western Academic Building and to ratify the approval accorded by the Chairman, B&WC on behalf of the Building & Works Committee. The cost difference will be met from CRR funds.	Considered the recommendations of B&WC & recommended to the Board for approval.

Item No. 51.7: To consider a proposed solution for a grievances on pay anomaly, created due to frequent policy changes, in case of the employees who joined the erstwhile University of Roorkee.

The Finance Committee took a note of a letter no. F.No.7-8/2017 TS-I dated 21.11.2022 received from the Under Secretary, Govt. of India, MoE, and considered the item with the permission to the chair.

The FC noted that the disparity among the same group of employees is not uncommon to IIT Roorkee and it will have large ramification on any change in hierarchy of the standard grade pay. The Finance Committee recommended to the Board that this item be sent to the ministry.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
