## Item No.23.1.2 To receive a report on the actions taken to implement the decisions taken by the Senate in its 22<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> December 2007.

The Senate noted that the actions have been taken on the decisions taken by the Senate in its 22<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> December 2007 with the following observations.

During consideration of action taken report regarding appointment of supervisor(s) for M.P.S. Chawla and reporting by Dean, PGS&R that Mr. M.P.S. Chawla is repeatedly requesting upon "appointment of Prof. G.K. Singh as his supervisor beyond the recommendation of the SRC & DRC and keeping in view of the various letters/e-mails received by the Director (Chairman, Senate), the issue was re-discussed.

Out of these two caretaker supervisors, one Caretaker Supervisor be appointed for Mr. M.P.S. Chawla as per his choice i.e. Prof. G.K. Singh, and other Caretaker Supervisor be appointed for Mr. M.P.S. Chawla from his major area of Research, i.e. Biomedical Engineering as per the recommendation of the SRC/DRC.

### Item No. 23. 2.5 To consider the issue of teaching Institute Electives to the students at DPT.
